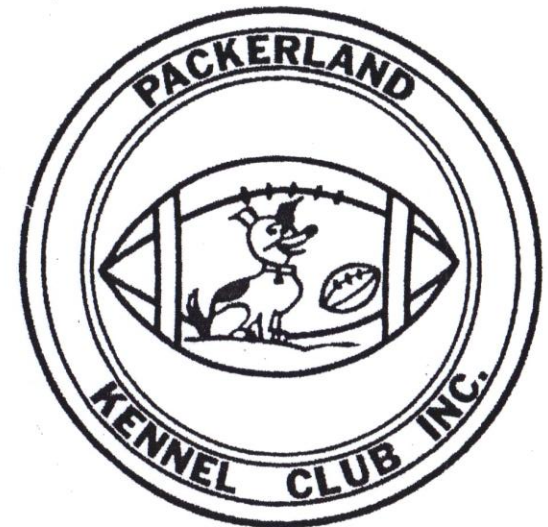

Training Fee

- *Only paid once per calendar year (January-December)
- *One yearly training fee entitles you and your family (head of household, spouse, and children under 18 years of age) to train any and all dogs in the family in classes during any or all of the training sessions during the 2011 calendar year
- Additional training fee is required for agility classes
