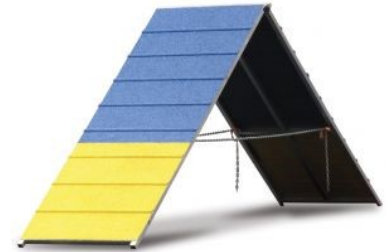
Introductory Agility – Wednesdays, 5:00 p.m. – 5:45 p.m.
