I also wanted to send out a big thanks to all of you who helped clean up the Kennel Club. We could not have had our B-OB Match without you all.

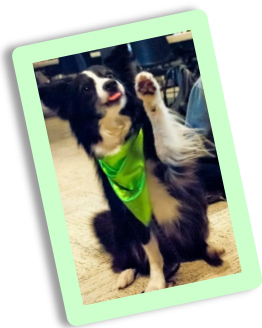
